

DHS Project History

- **July 2003** – Moratorium on school building projects announced by the Commonwealth.
- **July 2004** – Massachusetts Building Authority (MSBA) created by the legislature as an independent authority under the auspices of the State Treasurer.
- **January 2006** – MSBA announces plan for accepting Statements of Interest from communities for school construction projects.

DHS Project History

- **April 2006** – Board of Selectmen (BOS) authorizes the Danvers High School Planning Advisory Committee
- **August 2006** – Danvers submits Statement of Interest letter for High School construction project
- **September 2006** – New England Association of Schools and Colleges returns to review progress on issues leading to “warning” status.

DHS Project History

- **November 2006** – “warning” status continued with Special Progress Reports from school administration required.
- **April 2007** - DHS Advisory Committee unanimously approves final report
- **May 2007** – report presented to selectmen with three action items

Appoint MSBA building committee
Negotiate & hire Project Manager

DHS Project History

- **July 2007** – Moratorium on school building projects ends.
- **July 2007** – Statewide Deadline on Statements of Interest; 423 SOIs received from 161 districts
- **November 2007** – Special Progress Report submitted by School Administration to MEAS%C
- **February 2008** – Evaluation of North & South Cores completed

DHS Project History

- **March 2008** – Design and Construction Advisory Committee created to meet MSBA requirements
- **March 2008** – Project Manager hired (CMS)
Preliminary cost estimates for North & South Core developed
- **Summer 2008** – Feasibility Study initiated
- **February 2009** – MSBA approves Enrollment projection of 1,000 students
- **June 2009** – Feasibility Study Report submitted
