guidelines that achieve goals for the district including: enhancing the walkability, appearance and vitality of the area, expanding the mix of goods, services, dining, and residential choices, and responding to market opportunities in an attractive and functional way.

Participants will walk through the project area to identify current land use characteristics and opportunities for new development, rehabilitation, streetscape improvements, and other potential enhancements.
